

## STid's Declaration of NDAA compliance

The John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act 2019 (NDAA) is a United States federal law which specifies the budget, expenditures, and policies of the U.S. Department of Defense. The NDAA 2019 Section 889, prohibits the U.S. government from procuring video and telecommunication equipment from certain Chinese companies and their subsidiaries.

STid hereby declares that all of the following product lines that are manufactured to date are compliant with the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act 2019 (NDAA) and do not contain any "telecommunications equipment or services" banned by the NDAA, nor do they employ any component or technology of any system – substantial, essential, critical or otherwise – from the banned Chinese companies:
